### **Winner: “Flying Carpet”**

Statement of the Jury:

The winning solution is a simple, shapely and architecturally good project that also finds excellent solutions to logistical challenges related to the connection between pedestrians and public transport.

The winning solution shapes Trygve Lies plass into a flying carpet that both separates and connects the large urban space from north to south. “The bridge” which also is a roof above the entrance to the car and bicycle parking, will be an exciting shape for whole area and it divides the square into smaller and more intimate spaces.

The solutions connects the green park areas to the north with the urban areas in the south in a very smooth and elegant way. The jury finds “the flying carpet” to be very innovative with its solutions when it comes to architectural and landscape architectural instruments regarding green mobility.
